WEEKLY MARKET REPORT

October 7th, 2011 / Week 40

A positive week with all indices rising pushing the BDI to the 2,000 point mark, up just over 5%. The panamax segment is making waves this week with an increase of just over 10%. The small handies also added nearly 5%.

Panamax freight rates have risen to their highest levels for the last four months gaining support from the U.S. grain exports as well as increased Chinese coal imports (please note that domestic chinese production decreased because of an accident). Panamax freight rates from the Atlantic to the Far East have jumped to nearly US\$ 25,000/day. We have also noted a period fixture for an early 2000's LME for 4/6 months at around US\$ 21,500/day.

We also note that seaborne trade demand is expected to rise 6.4% this year and around 22% until 2015. Demand for the period 2004-2008 was 23% hence it is evident that demand is stil there but the issue now is on the supply side.

Second hand prices remained under downward pressure, but activity is there for those vessels willing to face realistic levels. In the dry sector we report the sale of the "CAPE WAKABE" (171,978 dwt / blt 1996 Japan) at US\$ 18.20 million to Greek buyers and the "BUNGA SAGA 9" (73,127 dwt / blt 1999 Korea) achieved a disappointing US\$ 16.75 million in view of its poor condition. Another panamax has finally been sold, the "TRIDENT ENDEAVOR" (68,788 dwt / blt 1990 Korea) for US\$ 10.80 million to European buyers. Sanko have sold their odd 8 HoHa box shaped supramax "SANKO SUMMIT" (50,655 dwt / blt 1999 Japan) for a realistic US\$ 16.50 million to Greeks.

On the tankers the market was stunned by the sale of the Japanese controlled Vlcc "TAKASE" (314,250 dwt / blt 1999 Japan) for region US\$ 28 million. Compare this price with the sale of the smaller Vlcc "Tenzan" (281,050 dwt / blt 2000 Japan) sold in August for US\$ 36 million and the "Yohteisan" (281,050 dwt / blt 2000 Japan) sold in April for US\$ 51 million !! We are all eagerly awaiting what will happen with the expected sale of the "Sky Wing" (299,997 Dwt / blt 2002 Japan).

Newbulding activity is subdued with very little activity to report.

In the demolition market prices remain under pressure and are now hovering around the 500 mark. As expected Bangladesh was inactive in view of the expected court hearing, whereas China was absent because of their

holidays. Pakistan paid 510 for the handy tanker "JAG PARI" (29,132 dwt / blt 1982 / Lightweight 8,775) on an as-is Colombo deal. All of the rest of the reported sales are for delivery India.






